Main Points from PCC Meetings on 22 January and 26 February 2024

PCC Meeting on 22 January 2024

1. <u>Deanery Plan.</u>

The PCC considered the proposal in the Deanery Plan for the 11 parish Benefice with 2 clergy. 3 parishes within the current Ely Team would be transferring to that Benefice. (Little Downham, Stretham and Little Thetford) The PCC approved the proposal and it would now proceed to Deanery Synod.

2. Recruitment of Team Vicar.

The recruitment of the Team Vicar was discussed. Ruth Holmes informed the PCC that she would not be applying for the post at the end of her Curacy.

3. Funding Agreement for Team Vicar.

The PCC was informed about a meeting with the Archdeacon in which the funding agreement for the Team Vicar was discussed. Due to an historical agreement, St Mary's does not pay the full cost of our 2 clergy posts. Proposals for making the transition for paying in full for the post in a way that was achievable over the next 6 years were discussed. The PCC wanted to ensure that the Team Vicar post would be guaranteed until 2030, and then approved the proposed funding arrangement.

4. Reintroducing Baptism with Sunday Services.

There was a discussion about reintroducing Baptism within Sunday services. The PCC members agreed in general with the concept of

Baptisms taking place during the Sunday services. However, the frequency and timings of the Baptism services would need to be programmed for the whole year and fit in with the regular sermon series. More work needed to be done.

5. <u>Finance.</u>
