Creative Minds will be enjoying a post-Christmas lunch on 22nd January so the first regular session of 2024 in the church hall will be Monday 26th February.

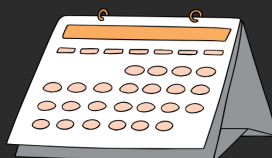
