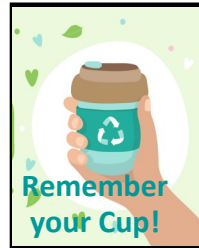

Green team tip of the month



GIVE NATURE A HOME—part 1. Hedgehog homes.

1. For a hedgehog to set up home in your garden, it needs to be able to get in. If you want them in your garden, make sure that there are gaps for them to squeeze through.
2. In autumn, hedgehogs will be on the lookout for a place to hibernate. Log piles, compost heaps and sheltered nooks under sheds and hedges are popular. If you would like to have a go at building one, visit RSPB.ORG.UK/HEDGEHOGHOME for instructions.
3. Remember that they like peace and quiet, so put the home somewhere it will not be disturbed.
