Finance Facts 2019

Regular Giving

Financial giving is an **essential part of our worship**, and church members are encouraged to plan their giving on a monthly basis as this enables us to plan our finances properly.

- Most people give by bank transfer; we use the **Parish Giving Scheme (PGS)**, and we ask donors to set up their Direct Debits via **PGS**. A PGS form is enclosed; please send completed forms to PGS.
- If you are a taxpayer please sign the **Gift Aid** declaration on the PGS form. This increases your gift by 25% at no cost to yourself. Last year Gift Aid was worth almost £30,000 to us.

Other Giving

- **Cash Gifts** may be given during services; please use the **yellow envelopes** if you pay tax.
- To make a gift for our **Mission Projects** please use the **white envelopes**.
- To support our **Building Transformation Project**, please speak to one of the Finance Team (see below).
- Please consider leaving a **legacy** to the church in your will. Such donations will enable us to refurbish parts of the building or install new equipment. A legacies leaflet is available.

Our Income

With the exception of a small amount of interest, some wedding & funeral fees, and rental of our buildings, **all our income comes from church members**, so please think realistically when deciding what to give.

Of course, not everybody will give the same amount; some can afford to give more, some less. The Bible talks of giving sacrificially, and of giving a percentage of your income (1 Corinthians 16:2); **'tithing' (10% of income)** is a good biblical starting point. Everyone should give willingly and not under compulsion, the motivation being Jesus and his generosity to us (2 Corinthians 9:1-15).



"Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."


Our Spending

Our 2019 budget for ministry and mission (excluding the Building Project) is **£209,825**.

This is **£17,500 a month** or **£4,035 a week**; on average about **£1,000** a year for each household.

In addition we hope to raise at least another **£10,300** for our charity and mission projects.
